Mini-bus short breaks - Due to low bookings and a high level of last minute cancellations over the summer, our trustees have made the decision to no longer run this service. Any remaining funding will be used on coach trips.

Children must:

- live in the Canterbury District (as per your local Council)
 - be aged 8-15 years old
- and be in the receipt of DLA (please send copy with your booking)

Please note:

- Staff have training and experience to look after all disabilities and provide your child with the care they require. **Parents do not attend.**
- Your child will need to be dropped to Windchimes by 9am and collected at 6pm.
- Places are limited and allocated on a first come first served basis, wheelchair spaces are limited.
- If you do not pay when requested in your confirmation, your place will be allocated to another child (*we no longer have the time to chase you, if you are having trouble paying please talk to us as we may be able to help*)
- If you have not recently filled out a care plan we require this **with** your application in order for us to make an assessment of your child's need and staffing ratio required. Your booking will not be accepted unless we have one.
