Arrive between 10 – 11 am

**Children and adults - £14 per person**

**Carer – 1 FREE per disabled child (must bring proof of disability)**

**Under 90cm tall – FREE**

Where children can ride, drive and operate diggers and dumpers including SpinDizzy, Mini-Tractors, Groundshuffle and Skyshuttle which goes 50 feet in the air and has spectacular views, don't forget your camera! With indoor/outdoor play areas, sandpits & rides for younger children.

## **Sno-Rings and Accessible Toboggan**

Folkestone Ski Centre, Radnor Park Ave, Folkestone CT19 5HX

**Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> August**

11am-12pm or 12-1pm

**£5 per child (for children aged 6 years and over)**

Children with physical disabilities sit or lay in an enclosed toboggan which is led gently down the slope. There are no hoists so you will need to be able to transfer your child. All other children will use the sno-rings. Please note there is disabled changing facilities with hoist.

## **Horse Riding**

Nelson Park Riding Centre, St Margaret's Road, Woodchurch, Birchington, CT7 0HJ

**Friday 10<sup>th</sup> August**

(sessions held during this period, your exact time will be given on confirmation)

A 30-min session will include 15 mins riding plus pony grooming/stable time. There is an outside play area and bouncy castle that children can play in after their session. No hoist is available but if children can be lifted onto a horse and supported safely they can ride.

A beautiful and popular location, situated on the outskirts of Dover with informal parkland around two ornamental lakes, the lower one is used for model boating. Enjoy watching the wildlife on the lakes, enjoy a picnic or use the tea rooms. There is also a children's play area.

The park is accessible to all, although some routes may be considered less accessible for wheelchairs and pushchairs. There are three small car parks but with limited space.

Disabled parking is available in the Tea Room car park.

Overlooking the idyllic views of the valley and the rolling hills of the countryside Eagle Heights is a gem of a find and definitely worth the journey!

Home to one of the UK's largest Bird of Prey with over 100 raptors they are also a wildlife sanctuary for Meerkats, Servals, other mammals, Reptiles, Birds and more!

## **Rascal Bay Adventure Golf**
