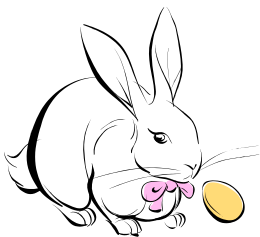

- be aged 8-18 years old
- have ASD and/or challenging behaviour
- and/or have manual handling requirements
- and be in the receipt of DLA.
