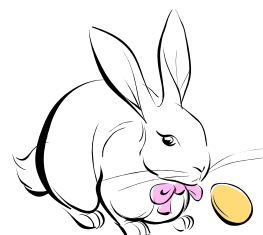

Children will be allocated spaces based on the group; therefore your child will not be guaranteed a place and priority will go to children who have not been before. Your child will be picked up from home. (Times will vary between 9am and 3pm) Children must:

- **live in the Canterbury District**
- **be aged 8-18 years old**
- **have ASD and/or challenging behaviour**
- **and/or have manual handling requirements**
- **and be in the receipt of DLA (proof will be req)**
