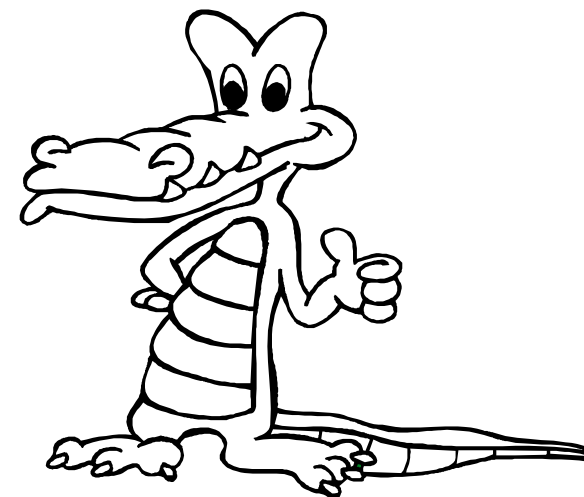

About SNAAP

SNAAP was developed in 2003 in response to parents and carers feelings of isolation and frustration.

A consultation highlighted a lack of support and information and also very little leisure opportunities for children with disabilities or special needs. As a parent led organisation, SNAAP's services are developed to meet theirs and their children's needs.

The focus of our service includes all of the child's needs including emotional, social, developmental and emotional.

We focus on the whole family and not just the child with the disability.

We are a registered charity available to all parents and carers with a disabled child aged 0-19, living in the Canterbury, Whitstable or Herne Bay area.

How we help

Information and support

Confidential information, support and advice on a wide range of issues such as support at time of diagnosis, benefits/DLA forms, help finding funding for equipment or maybe just a listening ear and a safe space to talk.

Resource directories

A comprehensive book of useful information including Social Services; Health; Education; Transition; Holidays and Short Breaks; Aids and Equipment; Rights and Benefits; Local and National Organisations; Leisure and Useful Websites.

Toy lending library

A large selection of therapeutic, educational and stimulating toys available to loan. Full catalogue of toys and dates of library are available on our website.

Library of books, DVD's and CD's

Available in the reception area of Windchimes this large selection includes all disabilities and issues affecting them. Also includes the full range of Makaton books and DVD's and Something Special DVD's.

School holiday activities

Our aim is to provide a wide range of good quality activities for disabled children and young people and their families including:

Family fun time

A few hours of fun and games giving relief for parents and enjoyment for all the family including siblings.

Taster sessions

Activities giving disabled children the chance to try something new.

Days out

To local places of interest to enjoy a day out with reduced entrance and the support of other families and SNAAP staff.

Youth activities

For young disabled people aged 11-19 to enjoy some 'parent free time', meet other young people and have fun. Held on Sundays and throughout school holidays.

Short break mini-bus days out

For disabled children aged 8-18 to enjoy a day out without their parents or carers. (criteria applies).
