

## Volunteer Roles within SNAAP

### **Sports Club Assistant**

**Time:** Fortnightly on a Friday 4-6pm

**Venue:** Body & Mind Centre, Canterbury High School, Knights Avenue.

This is an opportunity for children aged 8 – 19 years of age to come along, make friends and be active using the equipment provided. We require volunteers to assist the staff with engaging the children in activities, assisting with team games led by our sports leaders, setting up and packing away the equipment and ensuring the general safety of those attending.

### **Trampoline Coach (to attend Sports club)**

We had a volunteer trampolining coach who has now got a full time job and unable to help us out any more leaving the children desperate for a replacement!

We are looking for someone with a trampolining coach qualification to run a session with the children for about an hour. We are insured for this activity and meet all the necessary safety requirements.

### **Youth Club Assistant**

**Time:** Fortnightly on a Sunday 5pm - 7pm

**Venue:** Whitstable Youth & Community Centre, Tower Parade.

This is an opportunity for young people aged 11 – 19 years of age with any level of additional need or disability to come along, make friends and have fun. Volunteers are needed within this group to assist the staff with engaging the young people in activities provided, supervising areas/activities if needed (CRB required), ensuring the happiness and safety of those attending and helping to set up and pack away the equipment.

### **SNAAP-EY's Assistant**

We run 2 pre-school groups for birth to 5 year olds with any level of additional need or disability. These groups run during term time on a weekly basis. Parents/carers stay with their child during these sessions. We would like some volunteers to assist the staff with providing play opportunities and engaging the children attending in activities.

### **After School Club Assistant**

This group is an opportunity for families to attend and use the facilities at Windchimes, Herne Bay as well as make friends and enjoy the activities provided.

Volunteers are required to assist the staff in engaging the children in activities, supervise areas if needed (CRB required), and ensure the general happiness and safety of all those attending.

### **School holiday**

Throughout every school holiday we provide as many varied activities as possible for our families. Specific sessions will be announced a few weeks before each holiday.

### **Fundraiser**

SNAAP is faced with a constant struggle to find funding to sustain the activities we run. We are looking for enthusiastic volunteers to work with our fundraising team and who would be able to organise events (no matter how big or small).

**We ask if you sign up for any of these positions that you treat it as a commitment and attend on a regular basis. This is because these groups rely on volunteers in so many ways and it helps us if we know how many assistants will be there to help out. If you are unable to attend a session due to illness or another commitment we ask that you let us know as soon as possible as this may affect the running of the session as the activities planned may be dependent on your attendance. These commitments vary and are highlighted on the signup sheet.**
